Daniel

From the tribe of Judah (Daniel 1:6)
Placed in authority (Daniel 6:1-3)
Brought charges/accusations against him, innocent (Dan 6:3-5)
King felt guilt ordering Daniel to death/wanted to save Him (Dan 6:14)
King was held to the law to sentence Daniel to death (Dan 6:12)
Daniel prayed before his arrest (Dan 6:10-16)
Daniel thrown into a den of lions (Dan 6:16)
Placed in a den(grave) with a stone rolled in place (Dan 6:16)
The stone/grave was sealed with a signet (Dan 6:17)
Darius had the stone removed
Daniel was vindicated because he was innocent (Dan 6:22)
After the den and being raised his enemies were destroyed (Dan 6:23-24)
No bones broken, other bones broken (Dan 6:24)
The truth of God goes out to all people, nations/tongue (Dan 6:25-28)

Jesus

Lion of the tribe of Judah (Gen 49:8-10) (Rev 5:5)
King of the Jews (Mk 15:2), Has All authority (Mt 28:18)
Charges brought/no grounds for accusation/innocent (Lk 23:1-4)(Jn 19:4-6)
Pilate knew He was innocent/wanted to release Him (Lk 23:13-25)
Pilate held by law to kill Jesus (Mt 27:11-26)
Jesus prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane before arrest (Mk 14:32-49)
Messianic prophecy regarding Lions/cross (Psalm 22:11-21)
Stone placed over the grave (Mt 27:60-66)
Grave sealed with a signet (Mt 27:60-66)
The power of God had the stone removed
Vindicated by His innocence, impossible to hold Him (Acts 2:23-24)
Defeated the enemy via cross/resurrection (Gen 3:15)(Col 2:15)
Passover Lamb had no bones broken (John 19:28-36)(Ex 12:46)
The mystery of the gospel..... (Revelation 5:9-10)
